January 14th 2024 Council Meeting called to order @6pm by Mayor Smith Minutes taken by Manager/Recorder Deborah Oatman

The Seneca City Council meeting on January 14, 2025, covered several key topics and included important decisions.

Key Discussions:

1. Fire Prevention & Defensible Space:

The council discussed fire prevention measures, including using a machine to clear sagebrush, emphasizing the need for defensible space to reduce fire risks and suggested evaluating costs and planning for these efforts in April or May.

2. Council Member Updates:

 Andrea Officer was sworn in as the new council member. The council then elected Andrea Officer as mayor and reappointed Barbara Northington as the president of the council.

3. Budget and Projects Update:

 Deborah Oatman provided updates on the 2023 budget, and upcoming project the SCA grant to pave Shirttail Cr rd.

4. Code Enforcement & IGA with Sheriff's Department:

The council discussed the possibility of entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the sheriff's department for code enforcement and nuisance abatement. The council decided to explore this option further.

5. Fire Truck Issues:

 There was an update on fire truck repairs, the search for a new fire chief, and a discussion on heating options.

- Contact the Sheriff's Office to explore IGA for code enforcement.
- Schedule a Work Session on February 4, 2025, to plan the council's annual calendar and priorities.
- Follow up on fire truck repairs and the search for a new fire chief.
- Investigate Heating Options for the fire department building.
- Consider an Electric Gate at the fire department for improved access control.

Approval of Minutes

Mayor Brad Smith asked for a motion to approve December 10th 2024 minutes. Councilor Northington made the motion, second by Councilor Suzanne Hood, all were in favor, motion passed.

Bills Before Council

Mayor Andrea Officer asked for a motion to pay the bills. Councilor Northington made the motion to pay bills, second by Councilor Wenick, all were in favor, motion passed.

The meeting wrapped up by updating the safety deposit box and signatories and signatories for the bank of Eastern Oregon, read by Mayor Andrea Officer.
